


33 DAYS OF

Step 3:

Open Derry Diocese on Facebook or YouTube

Step 4: Cross off each *day*

On the prayer calendar overleaf, cross off each of the 33 days of prayer as you do them.

Followed on the 34th day (**Tuesday**, **11th February**) with a Consecration to Jesus through Mary.
