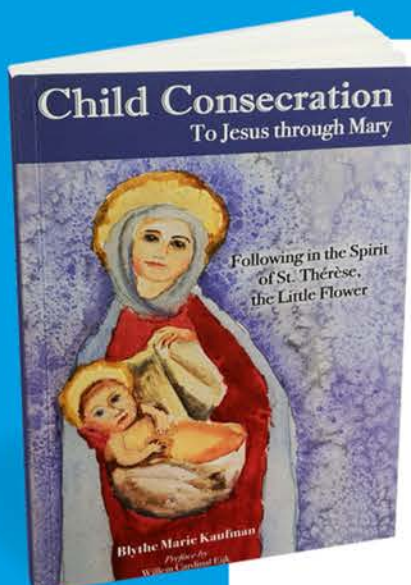

Jesus through Mary.

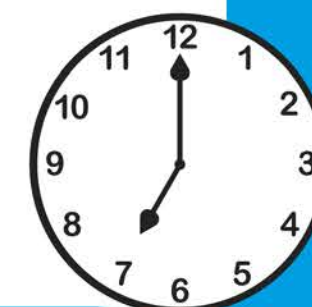

Step 4: *Cross off each day*

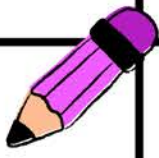
On the prayer calendar overleaf,

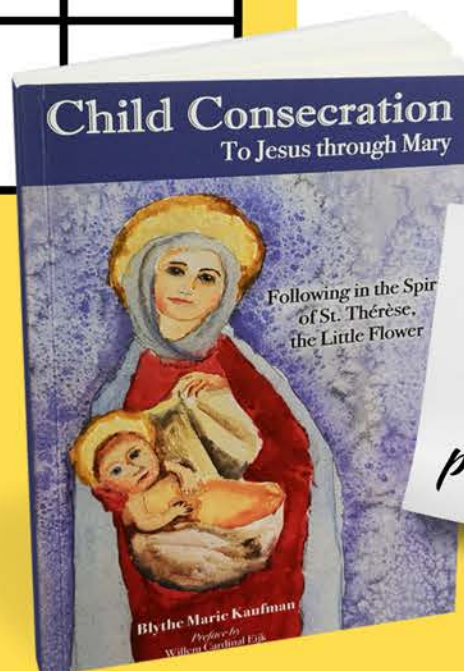
A decade of the rosary is made up of one 'Our Father', ten 'Hail Mary' prayers and one 'Glory Be'.
